Enrolment terms and conditions.

1. An invoice will be issued 14 days prior to the commencement of each term and due prior to the first class of the term.
2. Tuition fees are non-refundable or transferable.
3. Tuition fees must be paid in order for the student to attend classes. We are unable to accommodate late or non-payments.
4. Bring a friend: If a friend enrolls for preparatory classical ballet we offer a \$20 credit to your account.
5. Tuition fees are based on the school term and account for any closures due to public holidays etc.

Code of Conduct

By partaking in Fledgling Programme, counterpoint and such like classes and activities students and their families do hereby agree and undertake to:

1. Act with honesty and integrity at all times.
2. Demonstrate respect for faculty and staff at all times. If disrespect is shown to any teacher/guest teacher, students will be asked to leave class. If inappropriate behaviour or disrespect is continually displayed the right is reserved to request a meeting with the family to discuss continued enrolment.
3. Arrive on time for class to ensure that you are warmed up and ready to focus and learn to the best of my ability. We recommend arriving no later than 10 minutes before the commencement of the lesson.
4. Wear appropriate clothing when arriving and leaving the studio such as Fledgling Programme uniform or sufficient clothes to put over leotard and tights in summer months.
5. Be respectful and encouraging to peers and support them as a valuable member of our community.
6. Respect studio premises by keeping them neat and tidy, cleaning up after oneself and being responsible for one's property.
7. The Fledgling Programme and counterpoint has a zero drug, under-age alcohol and smoking policy.
8. The Fledgling Programme and counterpoint has the right to refuse to teach a student if they feel there is a health and safety risk at any point. In such a circumstance parents will be notified.
9. Staff are responsible for students for lesson time only. Please be considerate of other building users when dropping off/picking up.
10. Be on time, warmed up, fully prepared and ready for all classes and rehearsals.
11. If watching class, watch quietly and respectfully. It is polite to stand at the end if a bow is executed.

3. Students are under supervision whilst in class time only and counterpoint/the Fledgling Programme is not responsible for students outside their allocated class time.
